COUNCIL ANNOUNCEMENT

-- The Council would like to provide the congregation with an update in regards to the current state of the Building Fund. The following flood repairs have been completed and have been paid for: New HVAC system, flooring, duct cleaning, electrical work, and all other materials and labor that has been completed at this point. The total flood repairs paid-to-date is \$345,000, including a \$38,000 downpayment that has been made for the new pews that are on order and set to arrive in the Spring. The balance owed yet on the pews and carpet installation will amount to approximately \$125,000. As a result of these repairs, the Building Fund is getting low and the Council asks for your prayerful consideration for a donation to help relieve the remaining costs that will be involved.
